


COMPLIANT RIFLE GRIP (AR-15)

Per recent California law, centerfire AR-15 rifles with bullet buttons are now considered assault weapons and must be registered with the CA Bureau of Firearms.

Converting your rifle to "featureless" will exempt you from having to register it as an "assault weapon".

A "pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously beneath the action of the weapon," is used in the definition of an "assault weapon" under California Penal Code section 30515(a)(1). The CRG-15 grip is an important aspect in the building of a featureless rifle.

An evaluation by Michel & Associates P.C. has determined that our CRG-15 rifle grip does NOT meet the California definition of a pistol grip due to the "forced" placement of the web of the trigger hand, and is therefore classified as a "Compliant Rifle Grip".



Why this grip? Many options for eliminating the pistol grip on your rifle to make it compliant or "featureless"—such as kydex grip wraps or fins—are not comfortable, functional, or stylish. Others are very expensive and difficult to remove if you want to go shooting in another state.

In contrast, the Sparrow Dynamics CRG-15 rifle grip is affordable, easy to install/remove, comfortable, functional, and looks good, too!
